<b>SINOPSIS DE CONTENIDO</b>			
<p>Unidad I: Present of <i>be</i>, alphabet, greetings, introductions, self-identification, spelling.            Unidad II: <i>Yes-no</i> questions, short answers, making telephone calls.            Unidad III: Present of <i>be</i>, information questions, statements, short answers, plurals of names and nouns, numbers, possessive of names. Asking for addresses, introducing people, saying <i>good bye</i>.            Unidad IV: Prepositions of place, adverbs of location, ordinal numbers, imperatives, giving locations and directions.            Unidad V: Third person, Simple Present, articles, statements, questions, short answers, prepositions (<i>in, on, at</i>). Talk about jobs and occupations, exchange personal information.            Unidad VI: Ordinal Numbers, use of <i>was/Were born</i>, Simple Present in affirmative statements, irregular verbs, questions, negative statements, short answers. Giving dates, birthdays, talkin about family, languages, nationalities.            Unidad VII: Object Pronouns, expressions of future time, use of <i>may, I'll</i> and <i>going to</i>. Making business calls, talking about plans.            Unidad VIII: Demonstrative Pronouns, prepositions. Possessive Adjectives, past of <i>be</i>, talk about clothing, and personal belongings, colors.            Unidad IX: Present Continuous, articles (<i>a, an, the</i>), placement adjectives. Make suggestions, talk about the weather and time, talk about feeling, like and dislikes.            Unidad X: Demonstratives Adjectives, use of <i>some, any, how much</i>. Talk about food, shopping and prices.            Unidad XI: Past Tense, information questions in the Past Tense. <i>To, at, in</i>, with Definite Articles. Talk about past activities.            Unidad XII: Use of <i>there are/is</i>. Rejoinders <i>too/either</i>. Make small talk, exchange opinions.            Unidad XIII: Pronouns as objects of prepositions, Simple Present Continuous, use of <i>have</i> and <i>have gone to</i>. Make request and invitations, acquaintances and what you are doing.            Unidad XIV: Talk about possessions, give opinions about jobs, offerings favors.</p>
